## QUAID-I-AZAM MUHAMMAD ALI JINNAH'S LEADERSHIP AND HIS VISION OF PAKISTAN

The webinar on *“Quaid-i-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah’s Leadership and his Vision of Pakistan”* was organized by Sindh University’s Pakistan Study Centre in collaboration with Paigham-i-Pakistan on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> December 2020.



The webinar was presided over by Professor Dr. Fateh Muhammad Burfat, Vice Chancellor University of Sindh. He said: “we present gratitude to the leaders of Pakistan movement which was enriched by the visionary thoughts of Dr Allama Muhammad Iqbal, and guided and led by great leader and the founder of Pakistan Quaid-i-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah”.

Dr Burfat further remarked that Quaid-i-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah defined the case of Muslims in three words that

“Muslims are a Nation”. He justified the case of Muslims on legal and constitutional grounds. Dr. Burfat quoted Quaid-i-Azam saying that: “the problem in India is not one of an internal communal character but manifestly of an international one and it must be treated as

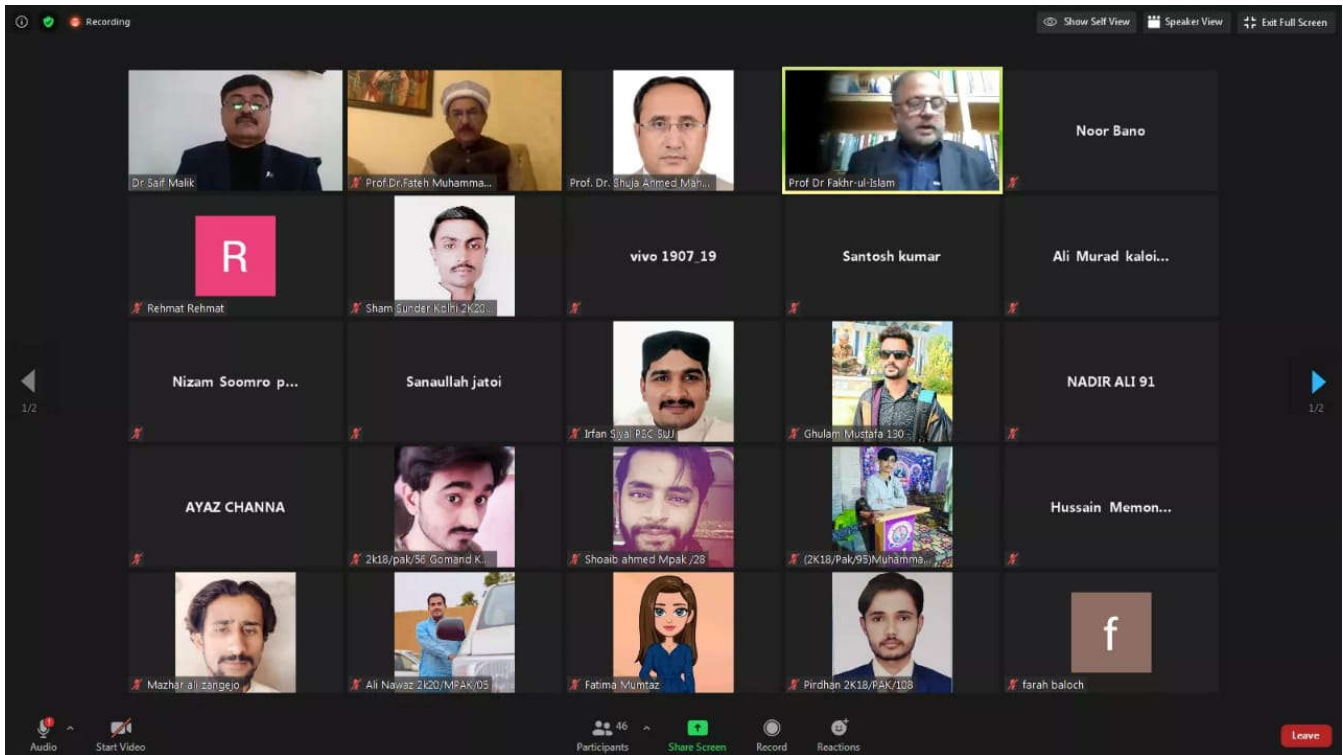


such.....They (Islam and Hinduism) are not religions in the strict sense of the word, but are, infact, different and distinct social orders and it is a dreams that Hindus and Muslims can even evolve a common nationality. Muslmans are a nation according to any definition of nation and they must have their homeland, their territory and their state”.

This statement of Jinnah said Dr. Burfat was proved important land mark in the political history of Muslims of British India. Eventually, Pakistan emerged on the map of world as the biggest achievement of Quaid-i-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah. It has hardly any parallel in the annuals of history for its being an ideological state.

The webinar was moderated by the Director Pakistan Study Centre Professor Dr. Shuja Ahmed Mahesar. He stressed the need to communicate vision of Jinnah to youth of Pakistan. He argued that Jinnah's leadership and his role in the making of Pakistan is widely acknowledged and recognized by researchers and historians at national and international level. He said Quaid-i-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah, a legitimate Muslim leader is considered as global leader and role model for entire world community. For understanding of today's South Asian politics, we need to understand the vision of Jinnah and his legal, constitutional and political struggle for creation of Pakistan as a Nation-State. While discussing the role of Jinnah Dr. Mahesar quoted Quaid-i-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah who declared Muslims to be a nation with its own distinctive culture and civilization, language and literature, art and architecture, names and nomenclature, sense of values and proportion, legal laws and moral codes, customs and calendar, history and tradition, aptitude and ambitions. In this way Jinnah responded the British policy of declaring Indian people as One-Nation. It was also Jinnah's biggest achievement that through Lucknow Pact of 1916, Congress was conceded Muslims with a separate statutory status in the Indian policy. This paved the way for further development of Two-Nation Theory enriched by ideas of Dr. Allama Muhammad Iqbal which were converted into reality by Quaid-i-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah.





Dr. Sad Khan Director General Institute of Management, Karachi widely published writer and analyst shared his research about birth place of Jinnah and discussed about the family and life of Jinnah. He said that Quaid-i-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah’s family moved from Kathiawar to Sindh due to famine occurred in this part of India. He further remarked that Quaid-i-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah was Sindhi by birth.



Professor Dr. Fakhar-ul-Islam, the Director Pakistan Study Centre University of Peshawar argued that 14 points of Muhammad Ali Jinnah was realistic and reasonable solution to communal problems of India. Further, he discussed the major achievements of Quaid-i-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah including the way he pleaded the case of Muslims through political and constitutional means.

Brig. (Retd.) Dr. Saif ur Rhman Malik (Tamga-e-Imtiaz Military) Director of India Study Centre, Islamabad analyzed personality traits and attributes of Quaid-i-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah including courage, confidence, commitment, and discipline. He further remarked that Jinnah knew how to transform idea of Pakistan in to reality.



In concluding remarks, Vice Chancellor University of Sindh Professor Dr Fateh Muhammad Burfat said our nation needs to follow the Quaid’s vision for Pakistan in letter and spirit. We strongly believe in Unity, Faith and Discipline. These are the guiding principles for our lives.



Further, Dr. Fateh Muhammad Burfat appreciated the efforts of Pakistan Study Centre’s Director Professor Dr. Shuja Ahmed Mahesar and his team for organizing webinars which will increase knowledge of our youth about the history and heros of Pakistan.
