Dear Members of the University Community,

I am honored to present the University of Sindh's progress report highlighting our collective accomplishments from 2022 to 2023. This year has witnessed exceptional growth, underscoring our unwavering dedication to academic excellence and progress.

Amidst our journey, we implemented crucial academic policies recommended by the HEC. This led to the inception of various new Bachelor of Science programs, coupled with a focused pursuit of program accreditations. Notably, our postgraduate programs underwent significant expansion, with approvals for 25 programs by HEC, resulting in heightened enrollment and substantial degrees awarded.

Our commitment to supporting students was exemplified through the disbursement of more than Rs. 400 million in scholarships over three years. This substantial aid, facilitated by collaborations with government entities and generous private donors, ensures equitable access to education for deserving students.

Research continues to be a cornerstone of our endeavors, strengthened by substantial funding from federal and provincial bodies. Significant projects in various departments and institutes have yielded promising results, consolidating our position as a hub for innovative research and collaborative ventures.

Infrastructure expansion, construction projects, and advanced ICT solutions, has streamlined administrative processes and fostered innovation. Initiatives like the National Incubation Centre and Software Technology Park underscore our commitment to technological advancement.

Moreover, we take pride in achieving the following additional milestones: Establishment of the Quality Enhancement Cell for Affiliated Colleges, aimed at enhancing the quality of education at these institutions. And Restructuring of the affiliation process for affiliated colleges, ensuring a more robust and efficient framework.

In the fiscal year 2022-23, I am pleased to report on our proactive financial measures. Austerity efforts have reduced our electricity bill from Rs.33M to Rs.18M, and further savings are expected through the detachment of utilities of the Residential Colony and ongoing Campus Solarization. We've adopted POL rationalization, Sindh Government's pension reforms, and optimized assets commercialization and rent. On the revenue front, the introduction of 13 new programs is projected to yield Rs.100M, and revised fee structures anticipate an additional Rs.40M. Petroleum commercialization operations aim for Rs.30M revenue. Our Finance Wing has streamlined fee deposits nationwide through the 1 Link Bill system and achieved salary digitalization within an hour through an HBL agreement. A noteworthy victory of a Rs.22M case before the FBR tribunal reflects our commitment to fair taxation practices. I am proud to share that our Finance and Planning Committee's negotiations have secured increased investment rates, ensuring profitable returns. These combined efforts showcase our dedication to financial sustainability.

I extend my heartfelt gratitude to our dedicated community—faculty, staff, students, and supporters—for their unwavering commitment and contributions to the University's relentless pursuit of academic distinction and progress.

ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY



The University of Sindh, the second oldest University of the country, was constituted under the University of Sindh Act. No. XVII of 1947 passed by the then Legislative Assembly of Sindh. The Act was subsequently revised and modified in 1961 and later. The Act of 1972 under which the University is presently functioning provided for greater autonomy and representation of teachers. From 1947 to 1951, the University functioned solely as an examining body. However, after its relocation in Hyderabad in 1951, it started functioning as a teaching university in pursuit of fulfillment of its charter and mission to disseminate knowledge. The largest University residential campus in the country, situated about 17 km from Hyderabad on the right bank of Indus River, was a rather desolate hilly track until 1955 when it was selected for the establishment of Sindh University Campus. The site was selected to be a university township away from the humdrum of Hyderabad city, which lacked room to meet the ambitious expansion program of the University. Interestingly, Jamshoro is virtually the gateway to the Indus Valley, now world famous for its civilization and rich cultural heritage.

The Ranikot Fort is located approximately 70 km to the north of the campus, in the northward continuation of the same hilly track, which become Laki Ranges, merging with the Khirthar northwards. Amri, an important archeological site, lies about 15 KMs, further north. Sehwan, a well-known township lies 25 km. to the north of Amri. Mancher Lake the largest freshwater lake in the region is situated to the north west of Sehwan. Travelling about 150 km. north through the Indus plains brings one to the site of Moen-jo-Daro, the most important archeological discovery of the Valley. The first teaching department, namely, Department of Education, raised to the status of Faculty later, was started in view of the great dearth of trained teachers in the country. The departments of basic Science disciplines as well as other departments on humanities side were gradually added by mid-fifties. The development of the present campus, designated as Allama I.I. Kazi Campus, at Jamshoro, about 17 kilometers from Hyderabad started in late fifties.



There are 58 teaching & research institutes/ centers/ departments functioning under various academic Faculties. Laar Campus at Badin, Mirpurkhas Campus, Dadu Campus, Thatta Campus, Larkana Campus, Naushahroferoz Campus, have been added under the umbrella of University of Sindh. The development programs initiated in 1959 have gradually though slowly borne fruit.

A beautiful pavilion-the Hyder Bux Jatoi Pavilion has been constructed to provide indoor games facility, track for athletics and sports grounds. Fatima Jinnah Gymnasium provides games and sports facility exclusively to girls. The Institute of Sindhology building, depicting the cultural heritage of Sindh, adores the entrance to the campus from the Indus Highway. The imposing central library building, named after Late Allama I. I. Kazi, the first Vice-chancellor of the University at Hyderabad, who conceptualized his campus, serves as a landmark even from a distance.



The campus itself has been named as Allama I.I. Kazi Campus as a tribute to the great scholar and visionary. The residential colony for the faculty and staff of the University provides on-campus residence to about one third of the total employees. The tree lined roads and greenery developed at the campus has completely transformed the Campus. The location of Sindh University sharing area with the Mehran University of Engineering and Technology and Liaquat University of Medicine and Health Sciences/complex in the neighborhood, has gone a long way in this transformation to a university township. The University provides easy accessibility and facilitates in organizing National-International Conferences, Symposia and Seminars on variety of themes related to all disciplines offered by the university. Intersports competitions and annual sports meets have become regular features. Our graduates perform above par in those competitions and win prizes proving their potential and interest. The museum and various art galleries of the Institute of Sindhology attract many visitors. Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto Convention Centre a major aid in carrying out applied and academic research in future.

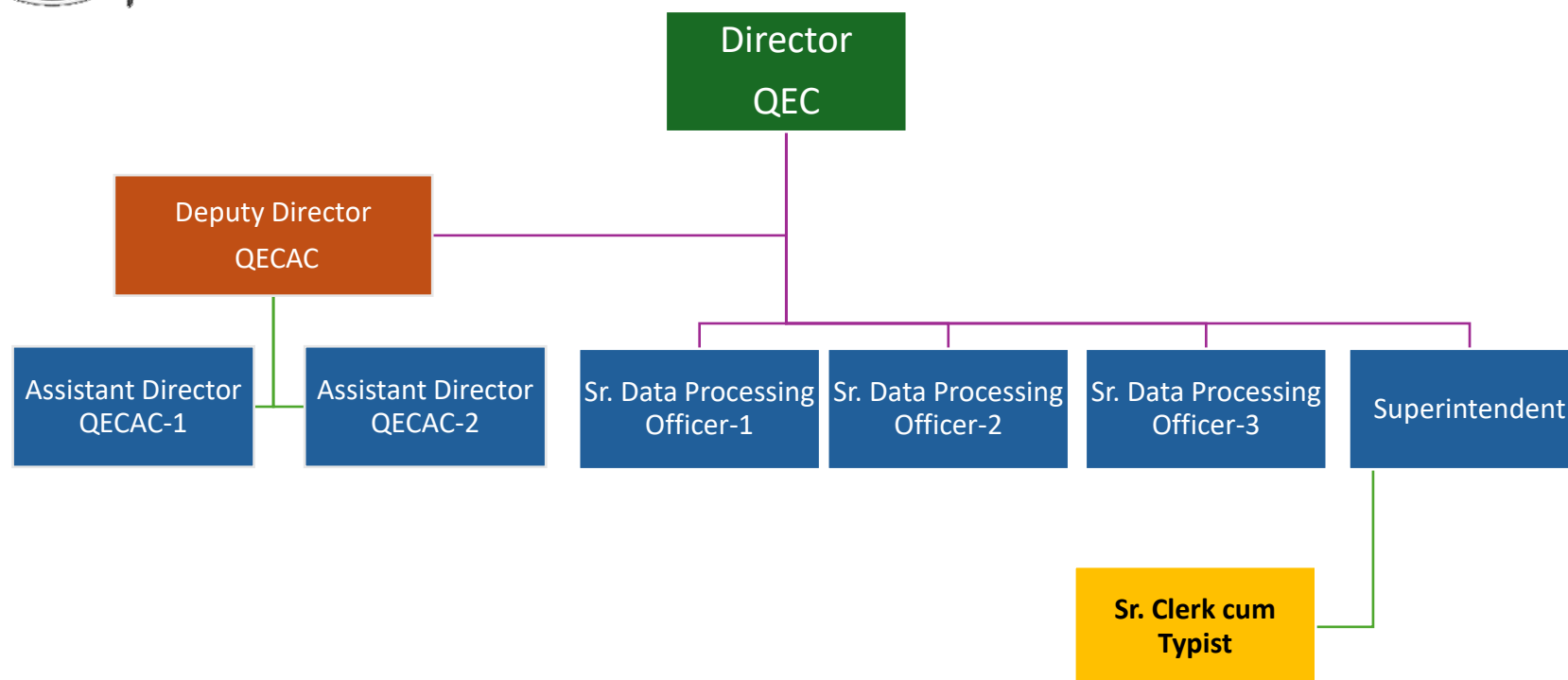

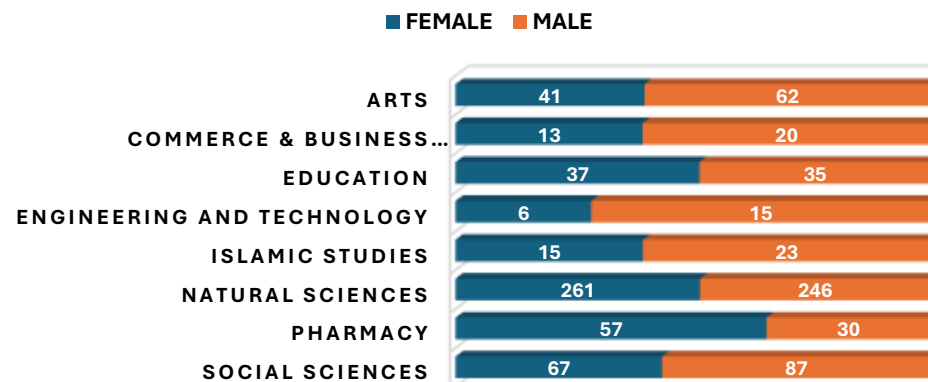

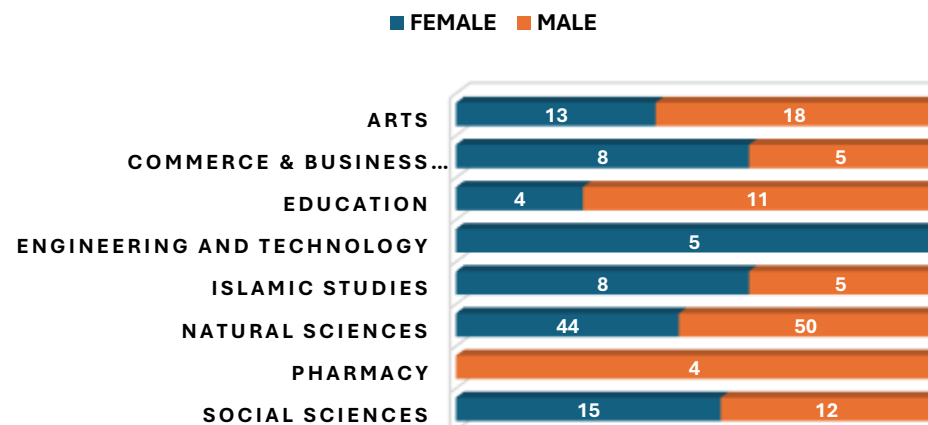

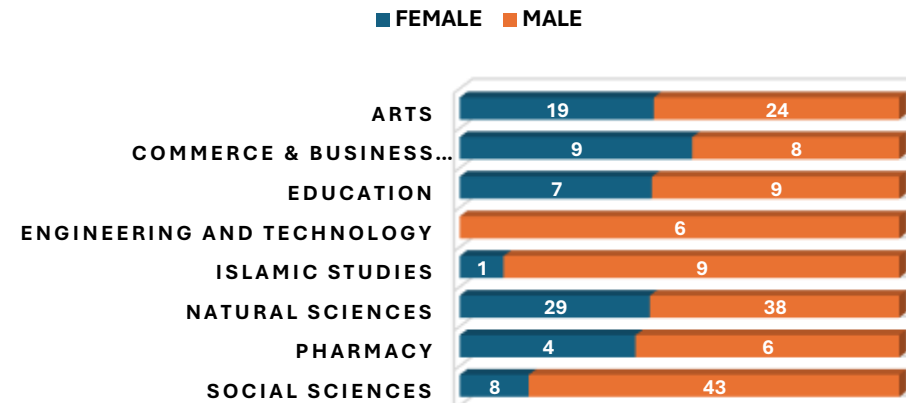

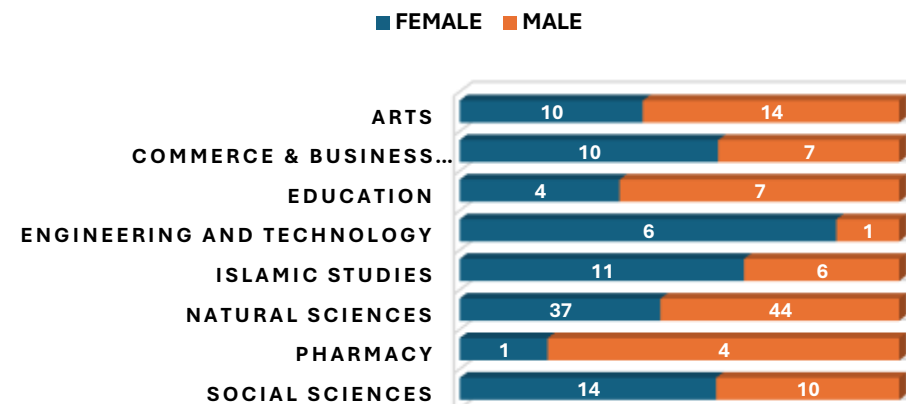

<p>It is ethno-musical gallery and performing arts, sound and film section. Sindh is rich in music. Its music occupies a distinct and unique position amongst various cultures of this part of the world. Despite the absorption, innovation and the influence of the Arabic, Persian and Indian music, Sindhi music continues to retain its original form and Rhythm. It has withstood the test of time in its charm, sweetness and inspirational melody that is easily accepted, appreciated and admired everywhere in the world.</p> <p>The great bulk of Sindhi music, it is to be noted, comprises of folk music. These folk tunes continue to enrich the traditions and customs of the people of rural areas but now that swift urbanization has started catching on with the people, the fear arisen that originality and purity of these forms might be affected.</p> <p>Music constitutes to be an integral part of Sindh’s cultural heritage, but hitherto very little attention has been paid to it. In this connection the Institute of Sindhology has already started working upon this project.</p> <p>The unit of the Institute of Sindhology has been visiting from village to village in every part of Sindh and has recorded the various items of Sindhi music, folklore, folk tales and tunes played on musical instruments etc. Thus the collection is being made available on tapes and cassettes. So far good work has been done in the province of Sindh and the material has been collected and preserved in the original form and shape of Sindhi music.</p>	<p>One of the functions of the Institute of Sindhology has been to guide, assist and facilitate the local as well as foreign scholars in their research projects concerning various aspects of Sindh, particularly Sindhi language, literature, art, culture, history, anthropology, sociology, ethnology and ethnography of various ethnic groups of Sindh. For this purpose, Research and reference library has been established by collecting and preserving the significant and important books, manuscripts and historical documents. It is one of the finest and the largest modern library in Pakistan with the most modern facilities available in our country. Efforts are being made to make it one of the best equipped and the best libraries on Sindh in the sub-continent.</p> <p>This Research library consisting of two buildings: one is old wing and other is extension wing; old building has 2 large Air-conditioned halls for books/ manuscripts and a reading room, and the new double storied building (extension wing) has 3 large halls on ground floor and two small on first floor.</p>

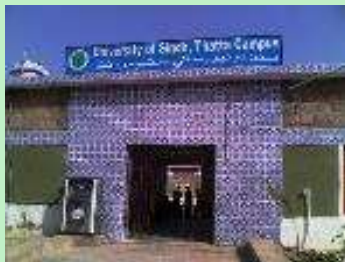
