- 07.02.2022: The Institute of Sindhology has accomplished the task of making its bookshop online. In this connection a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Institute of Sindhology and Leopard Courier Service has been signed. As per agreement the latter would provide the courier services at minimum charges to facilitate the readers who place the online orders.
- 25.01.2022: The Legal Rights Organization with the collaboration of the Institute of Sindhology staged a Drama focusing the social issues of Sindhi Society especially the rights of oppressed people, minorities and Sindhi women. The central idea of the drama revolved around the ordeal of the class system and its vices influencing the lower class.

- In response to the devastating floods that have recently affected the Sindh region out and out, Institute of Sindhology in collaboration with local authorities and healthcare partners, established a 3-Day- Medical Relief camp to provide essential medical services and relief to the flood affected population. The relief camp provided free medical consultations for flood victims addressing a range of health concerns including water borne disease and general health issues. The Relief was collectively provided to 632 affected persons.
- A large number of researchers were provided with the material at the Research Library of the Institute. Our collection encompasses a diverse range of historical documents, manuscripts, rare books and multimedia recourses. The Research Library retains a big collection. There are over 1, 50,000 books , 60,000 Periodicals and 5000 PhD, M.Phil and Master's Theses in the collection. The researchers that were provided with research matter during the period were: 1430 in number that included some renowned writers and scholars such as: Mukhtiyar Ahmed Mallah, Sarang Saheto, Dr Bisharat Ali Lajwani, Haseen Musarat, Abdul Razzaque Ghanghro, Dr Adam Butt, Inayatullah Laghari, Dr. Barkat Laghari, Dr Nawaz Ali Shah, Dr. Hanif Keerio and Dr. Ayaz Ahmed Chachar.
- The visitors came from diverse parts of the world to visit the Sindhology museum. They expressed their admiration and appreciation for the museum's extensive collection of artifacts, historical dioramas and other cultural and social things. These visits have not only been an opportunity for our scholar to engage with their international counterparts but have also fostered cultural exchange and knowledge sharing.
