



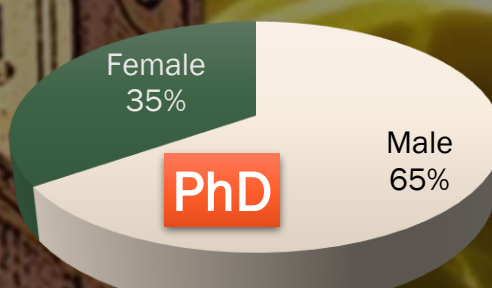
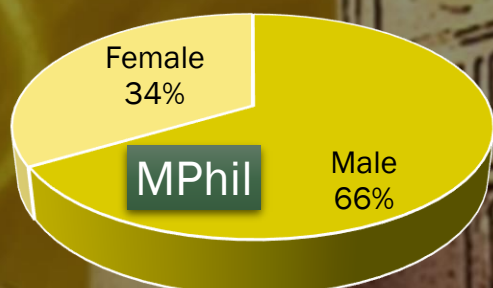
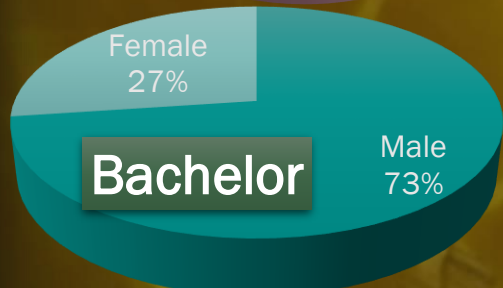

Extends learning opportunities to local schools and communities through tailored lectures and voluntary student-led schemes.

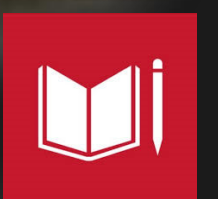
